



D'leteren Immo is about to apply for a building permit to renovate the D'leteren Group headquarters on rue du Mail.

The renovation project of the location on the Rue du Mail that was launched in 2022 will culminate in the introduction of the definitive building permit application in the spring of next year. A working group has determined the project priorities, which revolve around the reduction of the environmental impact, the enhancement of the architectural heritage, the integration of the building in its historic neighbourhood and the well-being of employees.

This reflection period has allowed the working group, assisted by the British architectural studio AL_A, to review the environmental, regulatory, historic and well-being aspects in minute detail. This renovation project, which straddles both tradition and modernity, confirms the Group's desire to maintain its Brussels roots. It is an added value for the municipality and for the city. The permit application also takes account of the recent inclusion on the Brussels heritage preservation list of certain elements of the buildings designed by the architect René Stapels. This decision is in line with the wishes of the 200-year-old Group to preserve the historic value of the site and its activities in a long-term vision.

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
